Use of Priory Rooms by other Religious Groups – revised September 2014

It is important to remember that the principal purpose of the Bull Street Meeting House is as a place of Worship.

The Management Agreement (clause 4.1.3) states “save in respect of use by the charity, the Agent (PR) must obtain written consent from the charity in order to use or permit the premises to be used for acts of, or as a place of, worship”.

As agreed by Trustees in May 2006 (Minute 06/12/07), any booking received by Priory Rooms requiring such consent should be referred, by the Priory Rooms Manager, to the Clerk to Trustees who will consult with the Clerk of Bull St Local Meeting and the Convenor of Elders Support Group, involving the Area Meeting Clerk if appropriate.
