## Travel advice and access

**Buses** 45 or 47 from city centre go to Cotteridge double-roundabout which is 100 yards from the Meeting House. Buses 11 (Outer Circle) and 18 pass the entrance.

**Trains** go to Kings Norton station; leave the station, walk up the hill towards Cotteridge and over Middleton Hall Road to Watford Road. The Meeting House gates are 100m further on the left between Poundstretcher and New Edge hairdressers, and opposite Heron Foods.

There is a small car park immediately in front of the Meeting House and bicycle parking is at the side. There is a ramp up to the entrance and there are accessible toilet facilities in the Meeting House.

Please come to this meeting which is open to all. It is free of charge and includes lunch but registration is essential.

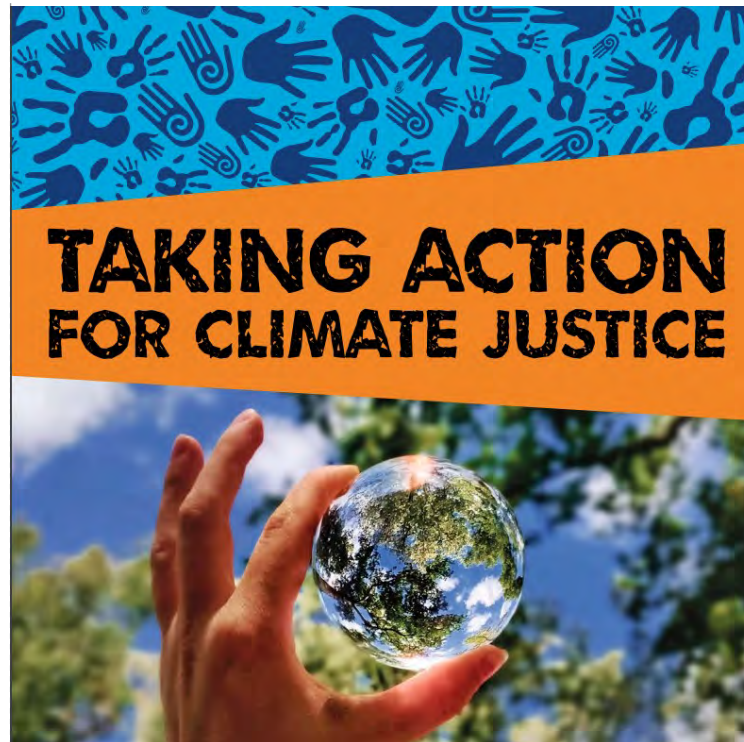
