Founded by the Friends Fellowship of Healing in 1954

Anyone who knows Claridge House is aware that our trees play an enormous part of our work as a Healing House, especially their benefits to mental health. In fact, we are members of The Quiet Garden Movement and the National Garden Scheme.

All our trees are covered by a Tree Preservation Order and many have Specimen Status.

Our trees have been stressed by the drought conditions 2025 - one of our oaks shed a huge branch and our magnificent Copper Beech needs additional works.

Our extra costs this year to maintain our trees has been £16,000 on top of our budget.

Claridge House is small (11 Rooms) so we are able to support our guests and groups alongside our Quaker values. We try to keep our costs as low as possible and we also offer a Bursary Fund to assist those in need of rest and renewal.
